Adam King explores landscape and the pastoral by way of two and three dimensional collages. His work reveals post-apocalyptic terrains pieced together from collected imagery of an urban consumer culture.

Historical landscape painting and surrealism meet with B-movie film sets in free-standing sculptures and collages that creep across gallery walls in a series of baroque patterns and swirls. Images of birds, butterflies, body parts, modern architecture and skeletons are held together with paper-clips and pins that speak of a modern construction ethos - easily put together and as easily pulled apart.

The sculptures are at once brightly coloured islands and human-oids with abstracted, stylized limbs. Covered with kitsch porcelain animals, and plastic flowers they form a theatrical tableau of the unlovely and the un-loved. Futuristic alien suburbias present a fragile façade ill-equipped to fight off the encroaching ‘vegetation’ that threatens to take over. These landscapes and their inhabitants command a disturbing reflection on our fixation with all things fashionable.

Invariably the final image is very different from the source material: the aim is to capture the spirit of the place as opposed to its naturalistic representation.
